DNRC reviews applications in the order that they are received. Lessees are scoped for comment on new SRUL applications. DNRC will consider lessee comments, anticipated user conflicts, application order, history of violations, MEPA analysis, and other environmental or land management factors. SRULs are issued at DNRC discretion and may be denied or modified to protect the best interest of the trust. The terms of an SRUL are based on the use, duration, and impacts.
