This cost share agreement is between the agencies identified above, as negotiated for the following incident in accordance with the Statewide Cooperative Fire Protection Agreement #17P00FM0001 executed between the parties on 2017 through 2021. The purpose of this agreement is to allocate financial responsibility as outlined in the Liberty Fire Decision Document and to describe the cost division.

Other conditions relative to this agreement:

- 1. Costs incurred by cooperators not engaged with the host agency or IMT in the fire suppression activities will not be included as a part of this cost share agreement.
- 2. Responsibility for tort claim costs will not be a part of this agreement. Responsibility for these costs will be determined outside this agreement.
- 3. Costs for accountable, sensitive, and durable property purchased by each agency will be charged directly to that agency and will not be shared.
- 4. Non-suppression rehabilitation costs are the responsibility of the jurisdictional agency and will not be shared.
- 5. Each agency will bill for their costs as outlined in the Master Cooperative Fire Agreement billing procedures.



Cost Share Methodology:

The costs incurred by the BIA, CS&KT prior to the fire burning onto the State DPA are the responsibility of the BIA, CS&KT.

During the cost share period (08/01/17-09/19/17) costs associated with fire suppression will be shared on a 50/50 basis. Roughly the final acres burned reflect a 50/50 split.

Each agency will be responsible for suppression repair costs on their respective DPA.
