Other conditions relative to this agreement:

- 1. Costs incurred by cooperators not engaged with the host agency or Incident Management Team (IMT) in the fire suppression activities will not be included as a part of this cost share agreement.
- 2. Responsibility for tort claim costs will not be a part of this agreement. Responsibility for these costs will be determined outside this agreement.
- 3. Agency specific costs will not be shared.
- 4. Costs for accountable, sensitive, and durable property purchased by each agency will be charged directly to that agency and will not be shared.
- 5. Non-suppression rehabilitation costs are the responsibility of the jurisdictional agency and will not be shared.
- 6. Each agency (including supporting agencies) will bill for their costs as outlined in the billing procedures addressed in the Statewide Annual Operating Plan for the 2018-2021 Master Cooperative Fire Management Agreement 18-FI-11010200-018.



Protecting Agencies' Strategies:

The strategy for this fire is the same for all agencies.

For the portion of the fire on both Madison County and USFS protection:

- 1. firefighter and public safety
- 2. protect structures and suppress the fire.

Cost Share Methodology and Rationale:

The agencies agree that costs will be divided by acres burned by protection agency. The final acres-burned percentages will be applied to all agency costs as determined by agency financial systems.

Acres burned by protection will be determined by the agency's GIS staff, with maps agreed upon by all agencies.


