Between the

USDA Forest Service: Helena-Lewis and Clark National Forest USDA Forest Service: Custer-Gallatin National Forest And the

State of Montana, Department of Natural Resources & Conservation

This cost share agreement is between the agencies identified above, as negotiated for the following incident in accordance with the Montana Statewide Cooperative Fire Management and Stafford Act Response Agreement (2017-2021). The purpose of this agreement is to allocate financial responsibility and to describe the cost division.

Cost Share Period: This agreement becomes effective on the date indicated below and will remain in effect until amended or terminated.

Other conditions relative to this agreement:

- 1. Costs incurred by cooperators not engaged with the host agency or Incident Management Team (IMT) in the fire suppression activities will not be included as a part of this cost share agreement.
- 2. Responsibility for tort claim costs will not be a part of this agreement. Responsibility for these costs will be determined outside this agreement.
- 3. Agency specific costs will not be shared.
- 4. Costs for accountable, sensitive, and durable property purchased by each agency will be charged directly to that agency and will not be shared.
- 5. Non-suppression rehabilitation costs are the responsibility of the jurisdictional agency and will not be shared.



6. Each agency (including supporting agencies) will bill for their costs as outlined in the Montana Statewide Cooperative Fire Management and Stafford Act Response Agreement (2017-2021), billing procedures.

Protecting Agencies' Strategies:

The American Fork Fire was managed under a full suppression strategy from initial attack throughout the life of the incident by all cooperating agencies.

Cost Share Methodology and Rationale:

The agencies agree to use a burned-acre split for this cost share. The acres are defined on the American Fork Protection Final Map provided by the GISS. As of 8/20/2021, the final acres are 21,892. Burned acres are divided among three counties (Park, Meagher and Sweet Grass) and two national forests (Helena-Lewis and Clark, and Custer Gallatin). The acres and percentages are reflected on the Protection by Agency Final Map included here as Appendix A. A final map produced by the DNRC did not show acres in the legend, but they were calculated and reflected in an email. DNRC map and email attached as Appendix B.


Appendix A – Map of Fire Area: Acres by Protection




Appendix A: American Fork Fire Protection by Agency Final Map
