Between the

State of Montana Department of Natural Resources and Conservation And the

USDA Forest Service - Beaverhead-Deerlodge National Forest

This cost share agreement is between the agencies identified above, as negotiated for the following incident in accordance with the current 2017-2021 Montana Statewide Cooperative Fire Management and Stafford Act Agreement #17-FI-11015600-010. The purpose of this agreement is to allocate financial responsibility and to describe the cost division.

Other conditions relative to this agreement:

- Costs incurred by cooperators not engaged with the host agency or Incident Management Team (IMT) in the fire suppression activities will not be included as a part of this cost share agreement.
- 2. Responsibility for tort claim costs will not be a part of this agreement. Responsibility for these costs will be determined outside this agreement.
- 3. Agency specific costs will not be shared.
- 4. Costs for accountable, sensitive, and durable property purchased by each agency will be charged directly to that agency and will not be shared.
- 5. Non-suppression rehabilitation costs are the responsibility of the jurisdictional agency and will not be shared.
- 6. Each agency (including supporting agencies) will bill for their costs as outlined in the Cooperative Fire Management Agreement billing procedures.

Protecting Agencies' Strategies:

The strategy for this fire is the same for all agencies.

For the portion of the fire on Madison County, USFS and DNRC protection:

- 1. firefighter and public safety
- 2. protect structures and suppress the fire.

Cost Share Methodology and Rationale:

Goose Fire began on USFS protection on 7/1/21. On 7/14 the fire gained significant acreage, crossing jurisdictional boundaries. Costs will be shared using the percentage of impacted acres during the Cost Share Period as described on page 1:

- The first 13 days: (7/1-7/13) will be 100% US Forest Service
- For 7/14 split costs 50/50 for costs accrued in Division J that full day reflecting protection acreage during rapid fire progression.
- Starting 7/15 through the end of the cost share period, costs will be split by protection acreage as mapped by the IMT Situation Unit: __% FS __% DNRC (final percentages to be determined at the end of the cost share period)

Agencies agree to use daily costs from the e-ISuite program as presented at the end of the incident using the Group Category Summary worksheet, (costs per day) to calculate the overall agency responsibility percentages. The calculation was derived using a Cost Share worksheet in Excel. Those percentages will be applied to the final, total, actual costs obtained from the agency financial systems.
