Cost Share Period: August 3, 2021, through the end of the Montana National Guard Deployment—September 5, 2021

Other conditions relative to this agreement:

- In accordance with the Montana Cooperative Fire Management and Stafford Act Agreement, 17-FI-11015600-010.
- 2. Each agency will bill for their costs as outlined in the Montana Cooperative Fire Protection and Stafford Act Response Agreement billing procedures. Federal agencies do not exchange funds.
- 3. Responsibility for tort claims will not be a part of this agreement. Responsibility for these costs will be determined outside this agreement.

Rationale for Cost Share:

The purpose of this cost share agreement is to share in the costs of mobilization of Montana National Guard (MT NG) hand crews for the benefit of all state and federal agencies responsible for wildland fire management within the state of Montana. These costs include, but are not limited to:

- Tools, personal protective equipment, and other needed Cache supplies
- Salary and vehicle usage of MT NG prior to being assigned to a specific fire
- Salary and travel for overhead (Crew Bosses) prior to being assigned to a specific fire

The costs described above will be shared based on the number of large fires (>100 acres) under the protection of each agency within the state of Montana during the cost share period. The number of fires protected by each agency will be divided into the total large fires during the cost share period to determine a percentage split. This will be tracked using the Northern Rockies Large Incident Situation Report found at
