This cost share agreement is between the agencies identified above, as negotiated for the following incident in accordance with the Montana Statewide Cooperative Fire Management and Stafford Act Agreement #L17FMA00001/17P00FM0001/17C00440901 executed between the parties on 02/21/2017 and extended through 12/31/2022. The purpose of this agreement is to allocate financial responsibility and to describe the cost division.

Other conditions relative to this agreement:

- 1. Costs incurred by cooperators not engaged with the host agency or Incident Management Team (IMT) in the fire suppression activities will not be included as a part of this cost share agreement.
- 2. Responsibility for tort claim costs will not be a part of this agreement. Responsibility for these costs will be determined outside this agreement.
- 3. Agency specific costs will not be shared.



- 4. Costs for accountable, sensitive, and durable property purchased by each agency will be charged directly to that agency and will not be shared.
- 5. Non-suppression rehabilitation costs are the responsibility of the jurisdictional agency and will not be shared.
- 6. Each agency (including supporting agencies) will bill for their costs as outlined in the Montana Cooperative Fire Management Agreement billing procedures.

Protecting Agencies' Strategies:

Full suppression and perimeter control.

Cost Share Methodology and Rationale:

The cost share methodology chosen for this fire will be based on acres burned according to ownership and jurisdiction. The DNRC is responsible for fire costs on State and Private lands. The BLM is responsible for fire costs on land with BLM protection. The BIA is responsible for Tribal lands. The following is the breakdown of acres burned in the Eagle Creek Fire:

Private: 4,517 BLM: 425 State: 497 Tribal: 1,735 Total: 7,174
