

COST SHARE AGREEMENT Between the Montana DNRC And the Lolo & Flathead National Forests

This cost share agreement is between the agencies identified above, as negotiated for the following incident in accordance with the Statewide Cooperative Fire Management and Stafford Act Agreement executed between the parties on 1/26/2023. The purpose of this agreement is to allocate financial responsibility and to describe the cost division.

Other conditions relative to this agreement:

- 1. Costs incurred by cooperators not engaged with the host agency or Incident Management Team (IMT) in the fire suppression activities will not be included as a part of this cost share agreement.
- 2. Responsibility for tort claim costs will not be a part of this agreement. Responsibility for these costs will be determined outside this agreement.
- 3. Agency specific costs will not be shared.
- 4. Costs for accountable, sensitive, and durable property purchased by each agency will be charged directly to that agency and will not be shared.
- 5. Non-suppression rehabilitation costs are the responsibility of the jurisdictional agency and will not be shared.
- 6. Each agency (including supporting agencies) will bill for their costs as outlined in the Cooperative Fire Management Agreement billing procedures.



Protecting Agencies' Strategies:

The strategy for all agencies associated with this incident is full suppression with full perimeter control.

Cost Share Methodology and Rationale:

Costs prior to 7/24 will be the responsibility of MT DNRC. Agencies will use the e-Isuite Cost Module to capture the daily costs recorded from 7/18/2023 through and including 7/23/2023 to determine the MT-DNRC responsibility for that period. Since agency financial systems do not break down costs by day, the e-Isuite Group Category Summary Report by Incident will be used. The total reflected on that report through 7/23/2024 will be subtracted from the combined incident actual total cost as calculated by the agency financial systems. The remainder of the combined actual costs will be divided by the acre-split percentage shown below. The e-Isuite costs will be calculated at the end of the incident because costs in that program are continuously updated as the incident progresses.

Cost share will start 7/24 when the Colt fire crossed protection boundaries to the northwest (Flathead NF) and east (Lolo NF). Actual costs will be divided by the acresplit shown below minus the dollar amount discussed above. Acres will be based on protection area boundaries.

Total acres, and identified protection acres, for the purpose of this split will be derived from the final ICS-209, section 47 "Remarks." Acres are calculated by the Situation Unit, reflected on maps, and indicated on the ICS-209.
