

AVIATION PRICE AGREEMENT

Call When Needed (CWN) Amphibious Water Scooper

This Amendment to Agreement **DNRC-FIRE-2021-0034-003**, hereinafter called the "Amendment #CPI2", is made and entered into between the Montana Department of Natural Resources and Conservation, Forestry Division, 2705 Spurgin Road, Missoula, Montana 59804, and Bridger Air Tanker, LLC, 90 Aviation Lane, Belgrade, Montana 59714.
