INSTRUCTIONS REDUNDANT WELL CONSTRUCTION NOTICE (FORM 635F)

How do I know my well is a redundant well?

Your well can be considered a redundant well in a public water supply system and you can file this form:

- If the redundant well:
 - o withdraws water from the same Groundwater source as the original well; and
 - is required by a State, federal, or Tribal agency.
- The priority date of the Redundant Well is the same as the priority date of the original well. Only one well
 may be used at one time.
- Within 60 days of completion of a Redundant Well, the Appropriator shall file a Notice of Construction
 of Redundant Well with the Office of the Engineer on a form provided by the Board. The Engineer or
 Designee shall review and process the Notice pursuant to the procedures set forth in subsection (2) of
 this Section.
- If a Notice of Construction of Redundant Well is not completed within the time allowed, the Appropriator shall:
 - cease appropriation of water from the Redundant Well pending approval by the Engineer or Designee; and
 - o submit an application for a Change in Use authorization pursuant to Section <u>2-2-104</u> of this Ordinance; or
 - comply with the well abandonment procedures, standards and rules adopted by the board of water well contractors pursuant to <u>37-43-202</u>, MCA, or any successor procedures, standards and rules that are promulgated in State law.

Complete items 1 through 4 ONLY if you have determined this is the correct form to file.

- 1. Eligibility Verification: If you answer no to either of these you cannot file this form.
- 2. Public Water Supply System Name: Enter the system name, mailing address, and phone numbers of the owner of the existing public water supply.
- 3. Redundant Well Location: Enter the land description for the location of the development. Describe the location to the nearest 10 acres if possible (two ¼ sections). Legal land descriptions, subdivisions, geocodes, and certificate of survey information may be obtained from the tax statements, county records, or from the Montana Cadastral system at:

Subdivisions – Enter the lot and block or tract number, and subdivision name.

Government Lots – In addition to the land description, enter the government lot number.

Certificate of Survey – In addition to the land description, enter the survey number.

- 4. Map: You must include a map with all required elements as noted on the form
- **5. Affidavit:** You are only eligible to sign this form if you have possessory interest in the public water supply system.

Possessory interest requires that the entity tasked with maintaining the water system sign the form. You must have a notary public witness your signature.
