

SELECTED EXEMPT TRIBAL WELLS

Existing Tribal wells are exempt from the Compact requirement of showing no adverse effect on existing groundwater rights recognized under state law. The Tribe may develop existing wells or their subsequent replacements to their full capacity. The primary municipal and domestic wells are listed in Appendix 8. A comprehensive list of all existing Tribal wells will be developed and kept on file at the TWRD offices.
